

the ambulatory setting and focusing on our state's Medicaid population, there has been a notable uptick in Lead Screening for Children. Amid the pandemic, routine well visits and WIC appointments, where lead screenings were typically conducted, experienced significant disruptions. However, heightened awareness coupled with the State's mandate for lead testing at ages 1 and 2 has resulted in the most robust lead screening performance in years, with expectations for continued improvement. Nevertheless, in 2024, lead

poisoning remains a persistent issue,
