We heard from you!

What healthcare quality improvement initiative(s) are you involved in currently?

The <u>Rural Wisconsin Health</u> <u>Cooperative (RWHC)</u> Cancer Prevention Taskforce focuses on breast, cervical, and colorectal cancer screenings. The RWHC Cardiovascular Disease Program aims to control high blood pressure, improve diabetes hemoglobin A1c levels, provide statin therapy, offer tobacco counseling, and enhance care coordination through Chronic Care Management, Principal Care Management, and Transitional Care Management.



Notable quality improvement initiatives supported by WHA include reducing skilled nursing facility rehospitalizations within 30 days, creating videos to help identify and respond to resident changes in condition, and developing educational toolkits to promote adherence to staff and resident vaccinations. Additional significant efforts focus on reducing opioid adverse events and ensuring all nursing homes have emergency response plans.

WHA's quality team actively contributes to initiatives aimed at improving chronic disease prevention and self-care in key areas such as diabetes, chronic kidney disease, and hypertension. Hospital-focused work includes quality improvement sprints targeting sepsis, opioid/adverse drug events (ADE), and readmissions.

Other initiatives include implementing overdose response protocols in Wisconsin emergency departments (EDs), providing training for medication for opioid use disorder (MOUD) in primary care, and initiating buprenorphine treatment in the ED.

Finally, WHA offers comprehensive training, support tools, and project management support for the implementation of the MOVIN (Mobilizing Older Adults Via a Nursing-driven Intervention) program, developed by Barbara King, PhD, RN, FAAN, and Dr. Linsey Steege, PhD, from the UW Madison School of Nursing.
